This guide lists Owens courses that meet requirements in EMU's [general education program](#) which consist of [core requirements and application of core requirements](#). Students who transfer with Ohio Transfer 36 (formerly [Ohio Transfer Module](#))[‡] will have satisfied core requirements and only need to complete the application of core requirements (see the [General Education Transfer Guidelines](#).) A grade of [C/2.0 is required](#) for transfer credit.

- Select 1 approved written composition course

[Knowledge of the Disciplines](#)

- Arts (GEKA) – Select 2 courses with different EMU prefixes

ART 101, 105, 201, DAN 105, 121 and 122, 131 and 132, ENG 230, MUS 100-103, *105(=GEKA), PHO 202, THE 100, 131, or 261.

- Humanities (GEKH) – Select 2 courses with different EMU prefixes

ARB 111, 112, ENG 200, 210, *215(=GEKH), 220, *225(=GEKH), 266, 267, FRE 111, 112, 211, 212, GER 111, 112, 211, HIS 151, HON 101, HUM 100, 275, PHL 101, 102, 250, SPA 111, 112, 211, or 212.

- Natural Sciences (GEKN) – Select 2 courses or course combinations with different EMU prefixes

BIO 101, 201, 202, CHM 105, 111, 121, ENV 101 and 102, GEO 111, PHY 111, 112, 115, 201, or 221.

- Social Science (GEKS) – Select 2 courses with different EMU prefixes

ANT 101, *200, CJS 123, ECO *201, *202, GOV 100, 111, 205, *207, HIS 201, 202, 220, 250, PSY 101(=GEKS), SOC 101, 240(=GEKS), SPE 102, or 110.

Application of Core Requirements

◦ Perspectives on a Diverse World – Global Awareness (GEGA) & U.S. Diversity (GEUS)

If admitted to EMU as a transfer student complete 1 course from either category

ANT *200, BUS 260, EDU 210, ENG *215(=GEUS), *225(=GEUS), ENV 101, GOV *207(=GEGA), GPH 106, 206, HIS 152, 270, MUS *105(=GEGA), SOC 220, or WST 100.

◦ Learning Beyond the Classroom (GELB)

If admitted to EMU as a transfer student complete 1 option from one of six groups.

This requirement must be completed at EMU.

Writing Intensive (GEWI) – 1 course

Complete one approved course determined by your major.

This must be completed at EMU.

‡ The Ohio 36 (formerly Ohio Transfer Module) satisfies specific general education requirements, but does not exempt prerequisite, program or degree requirements.

Students are encouraged to select courses that fulfill both general education and program requirements where possible. An advisor can assist in identifying appropriate options.

◦ OTM/OH36 proviso.

* The same course cannot be applied to more than one general education requirement.
