## General Education Transfer Guide Owens Community College

This guide lists Owens courses that meet requirements in EMU's <u>general education</u> <u>program</u> which consist of <u>core requirements and application of core requirements</u>.

Students who transfer with Ohio Transfer 36 (formerly <u>Ohio Transfer Module</u>)<sup>‡</sup> will have satisfied core requirements and only need to complete the application of core requirements (see the <u>General Education Transfer Guidelines</u>.) A grade of <u>C/2.0 is</u> required for transfer credit.
